EMPLOYEE EXPECTATIONS

An Argosy employee is clean, neat and well groomed for our guests at all times. Additional guidelines include:

- Clean shaven with the exception of well groomed mustaches.
- Hair to be kept neat and well trimmed.
- No earrings for males.
- No necklaces to be worn outside the shirt by an employee in uniform.
- While in uniform, female earrings are limited to one pair or matched studs or hoops, no larger than ½ inch in diameter.
- Uniforms to be worn by all employees except office staff and to be kept neat, clean and well pressed.
- Shoes to be brushed or polished black or kept white, depending on the season.
- No visible tattoos.
- No facial Jewelry.

An Argosy employee is aware of safe practices at all times to insure the safety of our guests, themselves, fellow employees and Argosy’s vessels and facilities.
