## FACT SHEET --TOURS

The **Harbor Cruise** is the tour that started it all. Since 1949, millions of guests have experienced this unique cruise. Set against the mountainous backdrops of the Olympics and Mt. Rainier, passengers marvel at the burgeoning and lively Seattle Skyline from the waters of scenic Elliott Bay. This tour departs daily year-round.

On board the **Seattle Lake Cruise**, see the historic houseboat district on Lake Union and Portage Bay, cruise past Husky Stadium into scenic Lake Washington, and view the amazing waterfront homes that surround the lake. This cruise was added in 1996 and operates a daily tour schedule. The trip departs from AGC Marina on Lake Union in downtown Seattle.

The **Kirkland Lake Cruise** offers a great view of the luxurious waterfront homes that line the lake. Since 1992, guests have viewed the spectacular sights of Mt. Rainier while cruising scenic Lake Washington. This trip operates March through November from Kirkland's Marina Park. This trip is often aboard the *M.V. Kirkland*. This historic ferryboat was named to the National Historic Register in June 1997.

Since 1963, the popular 2-½ hour **Locks Cruise** has been operating on both salt and fresh water via Seattle's famous Hiram Chittenden Locks. Live narration teaches how the Locks function, all while experiencing fantastic city and mountain views. Trips depart daily, year-round from Pier 57 on the Seattle Central Waterfront.

Argosy Cruises also has regularly scheduled trips to Blake Island's **Tillicum Village**. Visitors can enjoy a memorable and dynamic journey that includes an award-narrated Argosy cruise,

winning salmon dinner cooked in traditional Pacific Northwest Coast Indian style and a dazzling stage show *Dance on the Wind*.
